1. Sai Baba Samadhi Mandir



Sai Baba Samadhi shrine is the main Shirdi shrine where Sai Baba took Samadhi. The biggest attraction of Shirdi is the Samadhi Temple. Those who come to Shirdi to see Sai Baba start their journey at the Samadhi shrine.

2. Dwarka Mai Mosque



Half of Sai Baba's life was lived in the Dwarkamai Mosque, where he also influenced his devotees with words of wisdom and discourses. Samadhi Temple is easily reachable by foot from Dwarkamai Mosque. Sai Baba used to have his darbar for his disciples alone in the Dwarkamai Mosque.

3. Gurusthan Shirdi



Sai Baba was first observed in Gurusthan when he was sixteen years old. There is a neem tree here, and its leaves have medicinal properties and aren't bitter. Sai Baba was sitting under this tree meditating when Mata Bayjabai Kote happened to see him as a teenager.

4. Shree Saibaba Chavadi



After his death, Sai Baba took his last bath in Sai Baba's Chavadi Wah. See objects associated with Sai Baba, like antique pictures, Satka, and Padukas, when you visit Sai Baba's Chavadi. Sai Baba spent much of his last days sleeping in the Chavadi.

5. DakshinMukhi Hanuman Temple

Near the Sai Baba Chavadi is the Dakshin Mukhi Hanuman Temple. After receiving the darshan, you can go directly from the Chavadi to the Dakshin Mukhi Hanuman shrine. You can receive Lord Hanuman's darshan here by taking a seat in the temple comfortably for a while. Because Hanuman ji's idol faces south, this temple is also known as the Dakshin Mukhi Hanuman Temple.

6. Sai Baba Tapobhumi Mandir



Located in Kopargaon on the main Shirdi route, the shrine known as Shri Saibaba Tapobhumi Mandir is where Sai Baba first arrived before going to Shirdi. The temple is also known as Sai Tapobhumi since Sai Baba spent a significant amount of time there performing penance. This is known as Shri Saibaba Tapobhumi Mandir.

7. Janardan Swami (Moungiri) Maharaj Samadhi Temple

This temple, which is home to the Samadhi of Shri Rastrasant Sadguru Janardan Swami Maharaj, is located halfway between Shirdi and Kopargaon.
